RULES OF THE SOCIETY

- 1. Only LACS members are invited to sell their art/craftwork in the gallery shop, unless decided otherwise by the LACS committee. As a LACS member you will be given your own unique LACS number.
- 2. LACS reserves the right to limit the number of items by a member displayed for sale at any one time and to reject items brought in to the shop. The criteria for rejection will be clearly communicated to a member.
- 3. Items for sale must be entered for sale in the stock book under the member's number according to instructions provided. Items must be identified with a tag or sticker stating the price, member's number and stock number.
- 4. Items for sale must be then left in the back room for the shop display person to assess, approve and put on display in the gallery shop.
- 5. Members who do gallery duty pay 15% commission on sales. A commission of 25% applies to members who do not do duty (this is deducted from the marked price). The same rates apply for commissions taken through the gallery.
- 6. Members are responsible for the insurance of their work and that it is in good condition and correctly priced while it remains in the gallery.
- 7. A time limit of 12 months applies for all stock and members are encouraged to rotate stock often.
